



The Macerata Feltria Centre in the province of Pesaro and Urbino provides pulmonary rehabilitation and assistance to patients with very serious incurable disabilities, such as permanent vegetative states, minimally conscious states, or severe respiratory insufficiency.

The centre has 40 beds: 30 for out-of-hospital intensive rehabilitation and 10 for patients with very serious incurable disabilities.

Ordinarily, patients discharged less than 30 days ago from the acute ward are admitted.

Requests are assessed by the centre's doctors, and those considered eligible are put on a special waiting list.

The public relations office (URP) will then inform the patient or their family of the date of their admission onto the ward.
